The latest government advice surrounding the planning and occurrences of weddings in England, is as follows as is effective from 4 July 2020:-

- Weddings and civil partnerships can go ahead but with only 30 people including the couple, staff such as a photographer and witnesses.
- Government advises against the holding of wedding receptions, unless it can be limited to two households able to meet indoors.
- People should continue to socially distance, singing should not take place and hands must be washed before exchanging rings.

What to do?

- Talk to your venue, as they should know how many people they can accommodate with social distancing regulations in place.
- Decide with your venue if conducting the ceremony is possible whilst maintaining social distancing rules, and whether you are happy to carry out the ceremony with fewer guests.
- Receptions are essentially out of bounds for the foreseeable, and so we'll need to discuss postponing your reception to a later date, but is subject to our availability.
- Wherever possible, when postponing, we should work together with your venue to move your wedding date to a day all of us are available.
- Cancellation of services should be an absolute last resort, and where no other route is possible.
- Whatever the situation, keep all your suppliers informed.
